Mike Mattos is former principal of Pioneer Middle School in Tustin, California. Under his leadership, the school had consistent outstanding student achievement, ranked first among Orange County middle schools, and was in the top 1 percent of California middle schools. The school has also received National Blue Ribbon recognition. To achieve success, Mike implemented PLC concepts, sustaining a collaborative environment among his staff. His vision has united teachers, counselors, and administrators in a common goal—to educate all students. For his leadership, Mike was named the Orange County Middle School Administrator of the Year by the Association of California School Administrators.
